Contextual Information

Our Lady of Mount Carmel School is situated in Mullewa, 450km North of Perth and 100km East of Geraldton. The school was established in 1914 by the Presentation Sisters and their mission statement still continues to be relevant today. We are about developing an active faith community to 'Love one another as I have loved you' - our school motto. The school is a thriving co-educational school and caters for approximately 74 students from Kindergarten to Year 7. The majority of students live on farms and travel to school by bus. The increase of mining in the area has also seen an increase in the number of families moving to the town. The school has



strong links with the parish. Parental involvement is also an integral part of the school life and it is through this that the School Board and the P&F Association are able to provide the most needed resources. The school is dedicated to developing the whole child, intellectually, physically, socially and emotionally, based on the Gospel values of the church. Each classroom is equipped with computers and an interactive white board. The entire staff, teaching and non teaching are fully committed in providing the best Catholic education for children in their care.




